2014 Distinguished Alumnus of the Year


J. Roedel Jaeger, DDS '64



The Distinguished Alumnus of the Year Award honors a dental innovator who displays outstanding professionalism, philanthropy and community service. A tradition since 1956, the award recognizes an exceptional alumnus who has been chosen based on general dentistry or specialty, education, health care advocacy, research, administration and national and local dental services.

Dr. J. Roedel (Rody) Jaeger earned his bachelor's degree from Dickinson College in 1960 and his DDS from the University of Maryland School of Dentistry (UMSOD) in 1964. After graduation, Jaeger served as a captain in the U.S. Air Force at Wilford Hall Hospital on Lackland

Air Force Base in San Antonio, Texas. He returned to Baltimore in 1966 and established a private practice where he continues to work.



Active in organized dentistry, Jaeger has been a member of the Maryland State Dental Association since 1966, serving as president from 2003-2004. From 2002-2004, he was vice chairman of the American Dental Association (ADA) Council of Dental Education and Licensure. He has also served as president of the Baltimore County Dental Association and Maryland State Board of Dental Examiners. Jaeger was appointed to the North East Regional Board of Dental Examiners in 1985 and has participated on the examination committee since 1989. Jaeger is also a member of the ADA, American Association of Dental Examiners, the Academy of General Dentistry, the American College of Dentists, International College of Dentists and the Baltimore Association of Dental Surgeons. He has been a member of the medical staff at Franklin Square Hospital since 1967.

He joined the UMSOD Alumni Association Board of Directors in 2003 and served as president from 2005-2006. Jaeger is currently a trustee for the endowment fund of the alumni association. He resides in Kingsville, Md., with his wife, Eunice. They have three children: Anne, Jill and Jennifer and five grandchildren.

Linda DeVore Dental Hygiene Alumnus Award

Betty J. Howard, RDH '83



The Linda DeVore Dental Hygiene Alumnus Award is presented to the dental hygiene graduate who represents the integrity, intellectual curiosity, community-mindedness and leadership epitomized by Ms. DeVore. Nominees are judged based on their education and training, record of exceptional work experience, activism within the profession and impact on the future of dental hygiene.

Betty Jean Howard, RDH, earned her dental hygiene degree from the University of Maryland School of Dentistry (UMSOD) in 1983. After graduating from UMSOD, she entered the dental hygiene field and currently practices in Bethesda, Md.

Throughout her professional career, Ms. Howard has held leadership roles in several local and state organizations. She served as president of the Montgomery County Dental Hygienists' Association from 1987-1988 and as legislative co-chair of the Maryland Dental Hygienists' Association in 1988. She was appointed to the Maryland State Board of Dental Examiners in 1994 and was the first dental hygienist to hold the position of board president, serving from 2000-2001. She was named UMSOD Alumna of the Year in 2000. Howard also acted as the dental hygiene member-at-large for the executive board of the North East Regional Board of Dental Examiners from 2008-2011. She served on the UMSOD Alumni Association Board of Directors for 14 years and was president from 2011-2012.

She and her husband, Paul, reside in Potomac, Md. They have two children: David, 27 and Evan, 23.
